The Board of Frontier County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in regular session on April 29, 2020, with the following present by telephone conference: Steven J. Hall, Chairman, Kevin Owens, Vice-Chairman, J.R. Houser, board member and Darla M. Walther, County Clerk. Chairman Hall called the meeting to order at 9:04 A.M. and stated that the open meetings act is posted on the wall at the courthouse and available online. Owens moved to approve the agenda, Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Owens moved to approve the minutes from the April 7, 2020 meeting; Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Houser reported on the NACO Insurance Committee meeting with no increase in insurance rates for next year. Owens moved to approve the claims, Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye.

At 9:30 A.M. Nicola Buker with the Village of Stockville was present by telephone to discuss the armor coating project on the street running through the Village in front of the Courthouse. Houser moved the county to fund one half of Wellington Street armor coat; Owens seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye.

Discussion was held regarding the need for a sign technician on staff. Owens moved to purchase the simple signs maintenance agreement, Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye; Owens, Aye. County employee raises were discussed and tabled. Owens moved to offer the county life insurance policy and long term disability insurance to eligible county employees not on county health insurance; Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye. A permit to move a building over county road was approved for Wardcraft. A Road Crossing Permit was approved for Brad Wood. Discussion was held regarding what to do with the seed cleaner if nobody is available to operate it. A sprinkler system for the courthouse lawn was discussed. The Sheriff's Reports were reviewed and placed on file.
